the electromagnetic spectrum - teachengineering - the electromagnetic spectrum the em spectrum is the entire range of em waves in order of increasing frequency and decreasing wavelength. as you go from left right, the wavelengths get smaller and the **introduction the electromagnetic spectrum** - when electromagnetic radiation is spread out according to its wavelength, the result is a spectrum, as seen in fig. 1. the visible spectrum, as seen in a rainbow, is only a small part of the whole electromagnetic spectrum. the electromagnetic spectrum is divided into five major types of radiation. as shown in fig. 1, these include **the electromagnetic spectrum - lee.k12** - this is called the electromagnetic spectrum. 5 the longer the wavelength, the less energy the em carries. visible light is just a very small portion of electromagnetic energy. visible light comes in these colors: violet, indigo, blue, green, yellow, orange, and red. red has the longest wavelength of visible light, so it has the lowest energy. **unit 2 the electromagnetic spectrum -
